Position Responsibilities

- Collects product samples from the wash line, packing line and discarded potatoes.
- Analyzes, sort and catalogue samples by defect type
- Record and report data from all analyses and tests in the prescribed time and form and maintain statistical records in accordance with QC procedures
- Communicates results regularly with Quality Control Manager to ensure proper measures are taken during grading process in order for packed product be within specified tolerances
- While performing the responsibilities of the job, the employee is required to be able to lift up to 20lbs, sit or stand for extended periods of time, reach with arms and hands, climb or balance, stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl.
- Adhere to food safety, allergen, sanitation and employee safety policies and procedures
